

South Bay Organist to Open Twelve Church Music Festival

A Festival of New Music will be presented today at 4 p.m. in the sanctuary of St. Cross Episcopal Church, 1818 Monterey Blvd., Hermosa Beach.

The program will feature Mildred Kammeyer, organist; Stella Herrman, soprano; Kay Gratham, pianist; Trudy Troy, Contralto; and Dorothy Bailey flutist with the Summer Workshop Chorus sponsored by Los Cancioneros Barbara Mabin, director.

Arrangements for this festival combining the vocal and instrumental talents of 12 South Bay Churches were made by the Music Committee of the Pacific Unitarian Church.

Mildred Kammeyer will open

the contemporary program with organ works of Ernest Bloch, Joseph Bonnet, Joseph Clokey, Pietro Yon, Leo Sowerby and Van Hulse.

Mrs. Kammeyer's organ artistry is well known to South Bay audiences through her four years at the console at Palos Verdes Neighborhood Church where her husband Dan Kammeyer is Minister of Music. At the present time she is organist at Vermont Presbyterian Church in Los Angeles.

She studied organ at Redlands University under Dr. Leslie Spelman where she obtained a B.A. in Music. She has also studied organ with Clarence Mader, Robert Baker and Carl Weinrich and holds the Associate of the American Guild of Organists' degree.

East coast recitals have been given for Wanamakers in Philadelphia, Hunters College, New York, and Philadelphia and New Jersey Chapters of American Guild of Organists.

West coast recitals have included performances for Redlands University, 1st Congregational Church of Los Angeles, 1st Congregational Church of Long Beach, Mission Inn, Riverside and various South Bay Churches.

in Glendale, it will have one of the most extensive and complete electronic data processing systems of any Savings and Loan Association in the country.


