Plans Announced for Street Work

Supervisor Burton W. Chace today revealed plans for widening a portion of Walnut Street in the Lomita area.

The Regional Planning Commission, Chace said, has taken the first step for the project by approving the acquisition of Walnut Street, a local street, 5 feet on the westerly side from 252nd Street northerly 104.33 feet and variable widths from a point 90 feet southerly of 253rd Street southerly approximately 45 feet; and 5 feet on the easterly side from Ebony Lane northerly approximately 430 feet, making a minimum width of 45 feet and the corner cut-offs.


