

NEvada-6 Phones Changed to SPruce-5

More than 800 NEvada-6 telephones in the Torrance, Lomita, Wilmington and San Pedro areas are now being changed to SPruce-5, according to Dick Pyle, Pacific Telephone manager.

The change is being brought about because of increasing demand for Los Angeles exchange service in the Harbor area, Pyle said.

Only the prefix name and first number are being changed. The last four digits of the telephone numbers will remain the same.

New SPruce-5 telephone numbers have already been mailed to NEvada-6 telephone users.

FAirfax telephones in Torrance will not be affected by the number change, Pyle said.
