 An ordinance amending Section 425 of Ordinance No. 1494, changing regulations for the execution of the Master Plan of Land Use, relating to Watson District No. 114.  
 The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles do ordain as follows:  
 Section 1. Section 425 of Ordinance No. 1494, entitled "An ordinance providing for the creation in the unincorporated area of the County of Los Angeles of zones and prescribing area requirements and classes of uses of buildings, structures, improvements and premises in said several zones," adopted September 12, 1927, is amended by amending and enlarging the map of, and thereby enlarging the Watson District as shown on the map attached hereto.  
 Section 2. This ordinance shall be published in the Torrance Press, a newspaper printed and published in the County of Los Angeles.

**'Danger Signals' Show Need for Glasses**  
 Torrance parents were warned today to be alert to any signs that their children need glasses. "If your child reads by following the print with his finger, there's a fifty per cent chance he needs vision care," Dr. Leonard S. Miller, optometrist and president of the Los Angeles Optometric Association, said. "More than 80 per cent of all school tasks are based up vision," declared Dr. Miller. "And it is the prime responsibility of every parent to see that their children, especially those just learning to read, are not handicapped by faulty sight." The local optometrist listed several general signs which parents may take as strong indication of a vision problem. They are: body rigidity while looking at distant objects, tilting the head to one side, a tendency to rub the eyes frequently, thrusting the head forward, and obvious tension during close work such as reading, coloring small pictures or other similar activities. Excessive head movements while reading, holding reading material closer than normal, poor reading posture, losing the place, or simply avoiding reading and other close work altogether are all indicated as danger signals.
