This year is 5720 according to the traditional count, dating back to the time of the creation of the world. Rosh Hashonah, which means New Year, marks the birthday of the world. Persons interested in attending these services should contact Rabbi Front at Temple Menorah, FRontier 9-5983. Leading the ritual will be Rabbi Henri E. Front, spiritual leader of Temple Menorah. Assisting him this year will be Student-Rabbi Steven Frieze who is studying for the Rabbinat in Los Angeles at the Hebrew Union College - Jewish Institute of Religion, a branch of the oldest and largest Jewish Seminary in America. Directing the musical portions of the services will be the Cantor, Harry Newman and the Temple Menorah Choir under the direction of Fay Newman, organist. One of the musical high lights of the New Years Eve services will be the choral arrangement of the evening prayer "Hashkivenu," written by Max Helfman, composer and musicologist of The University of Southern California.


