Directors of the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California have voted to request Gov. Brown to call a special session of the Legislature to consider amendments to S.B. 1106, the \$1,750,000,000 bond issue passed at the recent session.

Terms of the bond issue, to be voted upon in the 1960 November general election, should be given thorough study to see if the proposal will provide sufficient funds to complete the water facilities set up in the Bill, including water facilities for Northern and Southern California, an MWD policy statement said.

Ray Payne has returned to Lucky Market, Torrance and Crenshaw Blvds., as manager.


Payne is a graduate of Torrance High School. He served in the navy during World War II. He is a member of the Torrance Elks Lodge and has been with the Lucky organization seven years.


