

**Cigarette Tax to Cost \$5,000,000 a Month**

Sacramento, — On July 1, California imposed a cigarette tax, leaving California the 46 state to Colorado, North Carolina, Oregon, and Virginia without state tax on tobacco products.

California's tax is three cents a pack. Collections during August were \$3,551,210, according to Richard Nevins, Fourth District member of the state Board of Equalization.

## Tax-Bill Machine Goofs But County Orders Another

After learning that an electronic miracle machine for which the county is paying more than \$2,000,000 has made a king-size goof in printing tax bills, the Board of Supervisors this week, over vigorous opposition of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, decided to spend another \$300,000 on still another "miracle machine" which already has cost the taxpayers \$600,000.

For the first time since 1923 the county tax bills, which will include the taxes imposed by cities, school districts, and other taxing agencies, will not carry breakdown of the tax rates.

This is because the new computing system, which is being used for the first time this year, cannot print the tax information.

The Supervisors were not advised of the error until it was too late to have the tax bills printed by the former method.

## State Drivers Pay \$79 Annually for Highways

Southern California motorists annually contribute about \$79 each to California's highway program, according to the Automobile Club of Southern California. Major taxes and fees used for highways in California are: state gasoline tax, 6 cents, costs \$299,000,000 annually; registration and weight fees, \$116,800,000 annually; state transportation tax, \$10,870,000; state diesel fuel tax, \$18,000,000; driver's license fees, \$7,600,000; miscellaneous fees, \$1,600,000; federal gasoline tax, 4 cents, \$200,000,000.
