

Immortality Will Be Scientists Topic

That man is immortal is brought out in the Lesson-Sermon entitled "Mortals and Immortals" to be heard in all Christian Science churches on Sunday.

The Golden Text is from Romans (8:8, 9), "They that are in the flesh cannot please God. But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you."

Also, in this epistle to the Romans Paul says (8:16, 17), "The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children,

then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ."

A statement to be read from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy declares, "In Science man is the offspring of Spirit. The beautiful, good, and pure constitute his ancestry. His origin is not, like that of mortals, in brute instinct, nor does he pass through material conditions prior to reaching intelligence. Spirit is his primitive and ultimate source of being; God is his Father, and Life is the law of his being."

The primary objective of the analysis is to determine the exact nature of the reading handicap, if vision is involved.

World-wide membership is more than 1,500,000, and the church maintains a full-time missionary force of nearly 6000 in some 50 missions.

Confirmation class will meet Saturday at 11 a.m. Barbara Penick will deliver the sermonette; the service will be read by Gail Press and Barry Shorr.


