## 924,787 Can Vote on Replenishment District Tuesday

A total of 924,787 voters in southern Los Angeles County are eligible to go to the polls on Tuesday, for a special election on the Central and West Basin Water Replenishment District.

The election will be held in Torrance, Artesia, Angeles Mesa, Avalon Village, Bell, Bellflower, Bell Gardens, Belvedere Gardens, Carson, Compton, Dairy Valley, Dominguez, Downey, East Los Angeles, El Segundo, Florence-Firestone, Gardena, Harbor City, Hawaiian Gardens, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Hollydale, Huntington Park, Inglewood, Keystone, La Habra Heights, Lakewood, La Mirada, Lawndale, Lennox, Lincoln Village, Lomita, Long Beach, Los Angeles, Los Nietos, Lynwood, Manhattan Beach, Maywood, Moneta, Montebello, Norwalk, Palos Verdes Estates, Paramount, Pico Rivera, Portuguese Bend, Redondo Beach, Rolling Hills City, Rolling Hills Estates, San Pedro, Santa Fe Springs, Signal Hill, South Gate, Vernon, Victoria Park, Welteria, Watts, Westchester, Whittier, Wilmington and Wiseburn.

The purpose is to restore the depleted underground water reservoirs to normal, according to R. J. Furlong, Mayor of Vernon and president of the Central Basin Water Association, and Allan Harris, industrial executive and president of the West Basin Water Association. The two groups are sponsoring the district.

Involved is an area of more than 400 square miles, a population of more than 2,500,000, an assessed valuation exceeding \$3,000,000,000 and the largest concentration of industry in the West.

The area traditionally has been supplied water by pumping from the underground and now pumps out 165,000 acre feet annually in excess of normal replenishment by rainfall. The accumulated underground deficit is 700,000 acre feet below normal water storage.

A replenishment district has the authority, under a state act passed in 1955, to assess pumps in order to buy imported water to replenish the underground.

"The proposed Central and West Basin Replenishment District would buy 165,000 acre-feet annually from the Metropolitan Water District for replenishment purposes," Furlong and Harris said. "It is estimated that a levy of about \$6.60 per acre foot pumped in the area would buy the necessary replenishment water. Total pumping is 300,000 acre feet so that this assessment would raise \$1,980,000, enough to buy 165,000 acre feet of untreated water from Metropolitan."

"Administration of the district will be paid for by a half-cent property tax levy per hundred dollars of assessed valuation, or less than a total of 25 cents per year for the average homeowner," the two association presidents continued. "The district will not levy any property tax for water purchase. All purchased water will be paid for through assessment on pumps."

Current replenishment activity by the Los Angeles County Flood Control District will put about 100,000 acre feet annually into the underground in the spreading basins of the Rio Hondo and San Gabriel Rivers below Whittier Narrows Dam. This 100,000 acre feet is water purchased by the Flood Control District for spreading, above and beyond the yield of the San Gabriel Mountains watershed which supplies natural replenishment to the southern county's underground water supply.

"This replenishment activity by the Flood Control District will make up the accumulated 700,000 acre foot deficit while the proposed Replenishment District takes care of the 165,000 acre-foot of annual overdraft," Furlong and Harris said. "The entire job cannot be accomplished by the Flood Control District because it now is using its maximum tax levy permitted for water purchase."

Replenishment activity will also be carried on through a series of pressure recharge wells along the coastal area from Playa del Rey to Palos Verdes and in the Long Beach area. A pilot project during recent years has demonstrated the feasibility of stopping salt water intrusion into the underground fresh water. The pilot project was conducted in the Hermosa-Manhattan Beach area by the state and county.

The Replenishment District would be governed by five directors, one director to be elected in each of five geographical divisions.

In Division 2 the candidates are Charles D. Barker of El Segundo and Jack T. Belasco of Hermosa Beach. In this division are the communities of Dominguez-Carson, El Segundo, Gardena, Hawthorne, Hermosa Beach, Lawndale, Lomita, Manhattan Beach, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills City, Rolling Hills

Estates, Redondo Beach, San Pedro, Torrance, Wilmington, and Wiseburn.


