Episcopal Clergy Hold Seminar on Old-Age Problems

The Church's responsibility in community programs for the welfare of older people will be explored by Episcopal clergy and laity today, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at a conference on aging at All Saints' Episcopal Church in Pasadena.

The Church - sponsored seminar has been arranged by the Rt. Rev. Francis Eric Boy, Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Los Angeles, and by the Diocesan Commission on Aging, headed by the Rev. Robert T. Stellar, chaplain of the Episcopal Home for the Aged, Alhambra.

Representatives from Torrance and 176 Episcopal parishes and missions in Southern California, will be in attendance.

Workshops on various areas in the field of welfare for older and retired persons, ranging from constructive use of leisure time to economics and medical care, will be featured.

Louis Kuplan, president of the International Gerontological Society and executive secretary of the Citizen's Advisory Committee on the Aging of the State of California, will be the keynote speaker.

The day's findings will be evaluated by Dr. Genevieve Carter, director of the program division of the Welfare Federation of Los Angeles, and the Rev. Kenneth Nelson, executive of the health and welfare division of the National Council of the Episcopal Church.


