There has been too much emphasis on the development of docility and conformity and so-called "equality," which seems to be producing a nation of nincompoops.

One must admit that the problem of educators has been greatly aggravated by the fact that so many homes do not provide children with the companionship and guidance they require. Too many parents are indifferent, or both parents work, thus leaving the children to shift for themselves.

Brown Blocks Censorship, Orders All Data Released

Gov. Brown today issued a directive to all department heads calling for "full and frank information to the public and genuine and complete freedom of access for the press."

He took note of recent concern that administration efforts to improve methods of handling public information might lead to censorship.

"Nothing could be further from my mind or intentions, and I think my 16-year record in public office bears that out," Brown said. "But the concern has been expressed by reporters and editors in whose objectivity and judgment I have great faith. So I felt I ought to set the record straight, both for my own department heads and for the public."

In the directive, he said he wants every question resolved "in favor of the fullest public knowledge and discussion."

Part of the text: 1. Any factual questions asked of a department or agency by a reporter should be answered immediately and directly. That applies not only to heads of departments, but to subordinates as well. There need be no prior communication with me or my staff.

2. Each department is free to issue releases on any matter concerning that agency on the authority of its own director. Departmental releases need not be channeled through the Governor's office. This does not change my long-standing position that directors must discuss major policy matters with me before a final decision is made. My staff is, of course, available for assistance and coordination on matters affecting more than one department.

3. I do not want censorship of any kind. I am informed that the principal concern of most representatives of newspapers, radio and television is that they fear self-censorship might be caused by uncertainty or timidity about the ultimate reactions of higher officials. Such censorship is just as dangerous to democracy as any censorship actually exercised by top officials, and the public's right to know is thus frequently infringed by indirection. I don't

want this to happen in this administration.

4. All media are entitled to equal access. Sometimes the special requirements of various media may require special handling, but the effort should always be made to maintain essential equality.

5. The only possible exceptions to be made to full disclosure are in personnel matters. The rep-






