

Merchants Ponder Move to End Parking Meters

The Torrance Retail Merchants Association is irritated over the number of downtown parking meters out of order and is considering circulating a petition asking for removal of the meters entirely.

Councilman J. A. Beasley gave the City Council this information Tuesday night. He noted many of the meters have been out of operation more than a month. Councilman Willys Blount declared some have been inoperative more than six months.

Police Capt. J. W. Maestri said the trouble is with the innards—the springs crystallize and snap—which have to be sent east to the factory for repair.

Blount, who is irked most by lack of specific and detailed in-

formation, asked for a report on how many meter heads have been shipped to the factory and when, and when they are expected back.

Maestri will report this information next week.

Mayor Isen, pursuing the subject, asked Jerry Scharfman, director of finance, for a report on revenue from meters on Cravens Ave. and Torrance Blvd.

He said there appears to be a can't parking in the metered areas on those streets and favors eliminating them if they are not paying their way.

Funeral Rites Conducted for Dr. J. L. Bloch

Funeral services for Dr. Jesse L. Bloch were conducted yesterday at the Cleveland Mortuary, San Pedro.

Dr. Bloch, who died Sunday, was active in the business and community life of San Pedro since 1924 when he began his medical practice in this city. A native of Athena, Ore., Dr. Bloch received his medical degree from the University of Oregon in 1919. He was a founder and director as well as past chief of staff of the San Pedro Community Hospital. He was chairman of the board of managers of the YWCA.

Among Dr. Bloch's business affiliations was his prominent part in the founding of First Federal Savings and Loan Association in San Pedro which merged with Glendale Federal Savings and Loan Association in June of this year. He was director and president of First Federal Savings and an officer and member of the advisory committee of the merged First Federal Savings-Glendale Federal Savings and Loan Association.

He leaves his wife Ruth, 11 Fig Tree Lane, Portuguese Bend; two sons; James, of Atherton and Lawrence, of San Francisco; a sister, Mrs. Oscar Lobe and Brother Adolph Bloch, both of Oregon; nephews, J. E. Bloch of Oregon and Robert O. Bloch, M.D. of San Pedro; and three grandchildren.

Interment was at Green Hills Memorial Park.


