## 'Y' Brotherhood Day Slated Friday to Help World's Poor

In the spirit of Thanksgiving, the YMCA of Torrance has designated tomorrow as World Brotherhood Day. Charles E. Stewart, board member, is chairman.

Stewart outlined four steps families may take to play an important part in World Brotherhood Day.

First, all families are being asked to give thanks for blessings enjoyed as Americans. The ideal time would be at the Thanksgiving-dinner table.

Second, families are being asked to discuss the many differences between our life and that of the world's average

man. Stewart said the average world citizen is hungry all the time, lives in a mud hut, suffers from chronic illness, and cannot read or write.

This picture represents two-thirds of mankind, and yet most of these unfortunate persons have hope for a better life — at least for their children.

The YMCA has an ideal way to aid the world's average man to achieve some portion of his goal. This is provided through YMCA World Service, the missionary program of the Y. World Service is supplying food, clothing, education,

camp, and leadership training to millions of youngsters in 76 nations of the world. In 35 countries of great need, World Service contributions keep YMCA services going.

The World Brotherhood Day program suggests that each family conclude their discussion of blessings and of their concern for the people of the world by having each member of the family give money to World Service. Even a few cents from the children will be multiplied many times in the nation that receives local contributions.

The third step is to drop by the Torrance YMCA tomorrow to deliver family gifts to World Service. The YMCA will be open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. to receive such gifts. World Service posters, literature, and movies will be shown to all who are interested.

A final part in this celebration of Thanksgiving and expression of interest for others will be a World Service rummage drive during the same hours tomorrow. All families are invited to browse among the rummage racks while visiting the Y. All proceeds will go to some struggling nation through the World Service program.
