## Hahn Blasts Hospital Delay 'May Add \$1 Million Costs'

Charging that delays in getting the new Harbor General Hospital under construction may have resulted in as much as \$1 million in additional building costs, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn this week introduced a motion calling for a progress report on the project.

Supervisor Hahn pointed out that on November 6, 1956 the voters approved a \$15,400,000 bond issue to construct a modern, new hospital to replace the ramshackle, temporary barracks now being used as the Harbor General Hospital.

## JOB MANAGER INVITES BIDS

Opportunity for South Bay residents to establish successful careers in the administration of California's employment security program in the Department of Employment was announced today by Murray W. Love, manager of the Department's Torrance local office.

An examination for the position of Employment Security Trainee will be conducted by the State Personnel Board at convenient locations throughout California on April 2, 1960. Deadline for filing of applications is March 11, 1960. Applications for the examination and full particulars about necessary qualifications and the nature of work done by employment Security Trainees may be obtained from the local office of the Department of Employment at 2007 W. Carson St.

Beginning salary of the position is \$376 a month, with an increase to \$395 after six months of satisfactory performance. A year's service as a trainee qualifies an employee to take promotional examination as a Journeyman Employment Security Officer or Disability Insurance Officer with a beginning salary of \$395 and a top salary of \$481 a month.

"Persons who qualify by examination and enter the Department's employ as a trainee will have the opportunity through subsequent examinations to go as far as their abilities will take them. The Department of Employment is known widely for its policy of promoting qualified employees to top jobs, and if I were considering beginning a public service career I would apply for this examination. The regular channel for promotion extends through five levels in addition to the journeyman class," Manager Love said.

Trainee positions exist in virtually all parts of California. At present, the Department of Employment is particularly short of trainees in its offices in Los Angeles, East Los Angeles, Compton, El Centro, El Monte, Huntington Park, Pasadena, San Bernardino, San Pedro, Torrance, Whittier and Wilmington.

An Employment Security Trainee participates in a variety of interesting employment security program operations, including job placement interviewing, determining the eligibility of claimants to receive unemployment insurance and disability insurance, and occupational testing and counseling.
