

## WHAT'S DOING

Safety's always in style at the telephone company. And though telephone man Don Bandoni may not look it, he's dressed for safety from the top of his hard hat to his climbing boots. Those glasses aren't to correct his eyesight, they're strictly for protection. So are the insulated rubber gloves, safety belt, and other equipment he carries. The special safety devices Don and other phone men have for each job pays off for them and their families, of course. Pays off for you, too, because safe jobs are good jobs—and good jobs attract the capable men like Don Bandoni who keep your service working right.

If you were to guess what is being held in this hand, what would you say it is? A new kind of paper clip? A hairpin? Actually, it's a thermistor, and I'm told it is one of the most sensitive temperature measuring devices known to science. Thermistors first saw the light of day back in the 1930's at the Bell Telephone Laboratories. And they are used by the millions in the telephone business as automatic volume regulators for your telephone service. Recently, thermistors have been carried in satellites and used by medical scientists to take temperatures inside human hearts. Proves that not all space-age ideas are new ones and, when you read about thermistors, you realize how many different ways telephone science works for all of us.
