

Summer School Classes Scheduled at All City Schools in June and July

Summer-school classes will be held in Torrance schools from June 20, through July 29 under action taken Tuesday night by the Torrance Board of Education. Summer-school classes are considered extensions of the regular school program, with instruction designed for bright, average, and slow students. Last year, average daily attendance was more than 6300.

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Classes will be offered on a high-school level in subjects for which enrollment is sufficient.

Eighth-grade graduates may take refresher mathematics, reading, Algebra I, practical typing, English skills, general science, instrumental music, vocal music, practical speech, exploratory foreign language, and art.

Elementary sessions will be held at all schools if enrollment is sufficient.
