**OUTDOORS WITH MEL**  
BY MEL SALTZMAN  
Warm weather and hot fishing. I've said it before and last week proved it, as the sun finally broke thru the smog and the water warmed enough to wake up the lazy fish.  
Salt water:  
The heavy concentrations of yellows which I've been writing about the last few weeks finally broke loose. The fish were taken both by the Redondo barge and the boats fishing near the Barge. These fish were up to 10 pounds which are good size for this early in the season. Boats were traveling to Redondo from as far as Malibu and most of the boats got some fish. Later in the week the fish moved a little further north and were working between the barge and the Bubble Hole. These fish were smaller in size but really hit. Some baracuda at Whites point and Rocky. Lots of Bonita with some fish up to 10 pounds reported. Surf fishing also picked up with the sudden arrival of the much needed sand crabs as bait. Perch to 4 pounds reported all along the Redondo surf with lots of 2 pounders mixed in. Catalina Island starting to come alive with big Yellows sighted but none hooked up yet. Big Calicos being taken on all San Pedro-Long Beach breakwaters but these fish are working toward dark and in the morning until about 7 o'clock. They are taking head head jigs as well as live bait. Best jig is a yellow head. Lots of Buttermouth perch at these breakwaters as well as Catalina Blues and some Opaleye. Still red hot at Redondo Breakwater for Bonita with feathers and Spoffers best.  
Fresh water:  
Puddingstone—Best Crappie fishing in many years with some Crappie proving 15 inches ad lots over 1 1/2 pounds. The water is low. Railroad Canyon, lots of bass being taken on surface and shallow running plugs. Crappie slow. The bass are about 1 to 1 1/2 pounds average with some about 3 pounds taken. This lake is as full as it has ever been.  
Lake Irvine. The opening could only be rated fair with some bass taken. The biggest bass reported up to this time was a 5 1/2 pounder but we know there are bigger ones in there. The lake is still low and the level seems about the same as the closing level last year. Unless the water rises don't expect to much out of this lake during the warm months. Matilija Lake: Both bass and trout fishing is picking up and is rated a good bet for this coming weekend. This lake is located about 2 miles from the popular Ojai and is fast becoming a good weekend fishing spot.  
This weekend sport. Try chasing the elusive Grunion. The run begins March 15 and ends on the 18th. The expected run will start at 12:00 Friday and 1:15 on Saturday. You cannot use nets or bags, only bare hands. You must have a license (\$3) and don't use light unless you must as they will move off the beaches where light shows.

**Jones to Drive '60 Ford in Nascar Race at Ascot**  
Five new 1960 model stock cars top the list of entries for Sunday afternoon's NASCAR late model races at Ascot Stadium, 182nd and Vermont. The racing program will include a four lap trophy dash, two ten lap heats and a 50 lap main event open to the twenty four fastest late model qualifiers.  
Heading the list of new car entrants is Parnelli Jones, young Torrance pilot, who has just returned from competition in the Daytona Beach 500 mile sweepstakes, and winner of last month's 100 mile sprint car race at Phoenix. Jones will be at the wheel of a 1960 Ford owned by Torrance Ford dealer, Vel Mitchell. Other '60 model entrants include Jim Cook, Norwalk in a new Dodge Dart, Ron Hornaday and Bill Hardisty, both of San Fernando in 1960 Fords, and Charles Chapman, Compton, also in a '60 Ford. Other entries include Don Taylor, Torrance.  
As a special added attraction the popular \$199 claiming stock cars will compete in a four event program which will include a trophy dash, two 10 lap heats and a 30 lap main event. Among those entered are Bill Foster, Newhall in a Ford, Ben Thomas, Canoga Park winner of the '59 P.R.A. Championship, Marvin Heinis, Sylmar, with fifty more entries anticipated.  
The double header program will mark the opening race of the season for the popular claimers on the half mile Ascot oval.
