## Police-Sponsored Car Clubs Schedule Inspection Sunday

A special inspection of vehicles in Car Clubs Associated, sponsored by the Torrance Police Department, will be held next Sunday on the Sears Del Amo parking lot.

The event, which may be attended by the public, will start at 9 a.m. Final car registration will be at noon, although inspection will continue until the job is done. Officer A. J. Jackson, car-club adviser, said about 60 cars are expected to get a fine-tooth-comb treatment.

Traffic Officer Don Hartel will be in charge of inspection, which will entail cleanliness and polish of the whole vehicle, including the engine, neatness of the trunk, presence of tools, and

appearance of the driver. Even his attitude is logged and credited.

Among other items to be inspected are lights, brakes from pedal to shoes, front end from steering wheel to shackles, rear end from lugs to differential, exhaust system, wiring and miscellaneous articles from flashlights to horn to first-aid equipment and flares.

At the next inspection, Jackson said, the clubs are planning to sponsor decals for windshields and throw the event open to the public.

### ABSENTEE BALLOTS TO BE MAILED

From March 23 through April 7, applications in writing may be made to the city clerk for absentee-voter ballots.

Any voter who expects to be absent from his precinct on election day, April 12, may apply for an absentee-voter ballot, given residence address in Torrance, mailing address to which the ballot is to be sent, and stating the reason for the request.

Each person must make the request over his own signature. A war voter may apply any time prior to March 23.
