**Candidate Tells Concern Over Job Layoffs**

Tom Coffee, Republican candidate for the 17th Congressional District, said he is concerned about loss of defense work for California industry and wage earners.

"With the know-how, research facilities, supply of skilled labor, and natural assets of Southern California, it is not at all understandable why this area should not be receiving its share of government spending," Coffee said.

In a meeting of Republican workers last night, Coffee pledged that if he is elected he will devote his energies in the committees of Congress concerned with defense spending to ensure the fact that the many jobs tied in with the defense, electronic, and aircraft industry are secure.

Coffee said that at present, the Southern California aircraft industry is not receiving its fair share of contracts, and that it is not being adequately represented in the Congress.

"It is not a wise government policy to train men in highly technical skills, spend several years on a project, and then see it moved to another agency or plant due to regional situations of unemployment or for political preference."

**Isham Speaker at Republican Meeting Here**

Vincent L. Isham, candidate for the Republican nomination of the 17th Congressional District, was guest speaker at the Torrance Republican Club at its meeting Tuesday.

Isham, a local real-estate man, has been in business since 1945. Because of his extensive business operations with local home owners, Isham is acutely aware of the issues in the district, he said.

As a result of his business dealings with small-home owners, he has acquired an understanding of the problems and aspirations of the average home owner, he declared.

People in this district, he said, demand less tax on income, increased production in local defense plants, a reduction in the eligible age for Social Security benefits from 65 to 62, and in hardship cases from 65 to 60.

Isham is for a civil-rights program as sponsored by the Eisenhower Administration.
