Torrance YMCA Still Has Vacancies on Some of Its Summer Camping Trips

The Torrance YMCA today announced the first of 12 summer camps has completed its enrollment.

Twenty-five older boys have signed for the Y's Tri-Canyon Caravan to Bryce, Zion and Grand Canyon national parks this summer.

Douglas Cannon, director of the tour, said a top crew of counselors has been recruited for the trip. The boys will travel more than 2000 miles as they sight-see, fish, hike, swim and explore.

Room for five more boys between 11 and 14 remains on the Florence Lake High Sierra base camp from June 12 to 18.

These boys will travel on remote power company roads into the heart of the Sierra. They will set up a base camp at Jackass Meadow and then will hike out to fish, boat on Florence Lake, swim in icy streams, and backpack over Bear Dome at 9980 feet to Lake Thomas A. Edison.

During their stay, they will visit a section of the John Muir Trail, Vermillion Cliffs, and popular Huntington and Shaver lakes.

The YMCA's longest tour of

the summer is a trip to Grand Teton National Park from June 22 to July 3. This caravan is open to all boys 13 and older, and will visit Salt Lake City, Bear Lake, Snake River, Jackson Hole, Old Faithful Geyser in Yellowstone, Idaho Falls, Craters of the Moon, and portions of the eastern Sierra on the return trip.

While staying in the Teton National Park, the boys will learn mountain climbing at a ranger school, along with the other Rocky Mountain activities.

The trip for older girls is half-filled. Girls 12 and older will travel up the coast to visit redwoods, Carmel, Monterey, and many other scenic

spots from July 16 to 23.

There is space for boys or girls 9 to 12 in the two younger camp periods at Round Meadow and Mozdumdar.

Both camps will operate Aug. 6 to 13. Nature lore, archery, crafts, swimming lessons, hiking, horseback riding and campfires will highlight these two camps.

The YMCA's teen-age director, Paul Slyh, said youngsters have sold 600 cases of YMCA peanuts so far in a project to help earn their way to a Y Camp.
