## Amerigo, Bagdad in Hollypark Feature

The Californian, the first of five \$100,000 added races to be renewed during the current big racing season at Hollywood Park, will attract one of the most outstanding fields in history on Saturday, May 28.

Headed by the sensational Fleet Nasrullah, Amerigo and Bagdad, fifteen of the original 28 nominees seem likely to go postward in the rich mile and one-sixteenth race.

Fleet Nasrullah set a new track record of 1:08 1/5 for six furlongs in winning the Hollywood Premiere effortlessly, and is equally at home over a distance of ground since Trainer Jim Nazworthy taught him how to be rated.

As Santa Anita three months ago the five-year-old son of Nasrullah established a new American record of 1:46 4/5 for a mile and one-eighth over the grass. A bit later he just missed victory and the mile and one-quarter Santa Anita Handicap by a head, being nipped by Linmold.

Although he was named for The Californian, Linmold will be forced to miss the race. He had a piece of a splint bone removed at Bay Meadows, but is back galloping soundly at Hollypark and will start later in the meeting.

Fleet Nasrullah's stiffest competition figures to come from Amerigo, the nation's leading money winning horse so far in 1960, and Bagdad. Amerigo figured in the four-horse blanket finish of the Santa Anita Handicap,

won the \$100,000 added San Juan Capistrano Handicap a week later and then returned to Florida to be runner up to Bald Eagle in the Gulfstream Handicap.

Bagdad, who, with Amerigo, made the Los Angeles Handicap a stepping stone to The Californian, has never looked better in his life. He was an easy winner of the Hollywood Derby last year after running second to Sword Dancer in the Belmont Stakes. He was second in the Malibu and Maturity Stakes at Santa Anita and won the San Antonio Handicap.




