ECC FINISHES 9th IN TOURNEY

El Camino golfers can hang-up the spiked shoes, wring out the crying towels, and stow away the little white spheres for another sea-

son after finishing ninth in the state Monday.

The golfers bagged the best record of any El Camino athletic team this year while taking second place in conference play.

The Warriors' four-man team, sent to Mesa Verde and Santa Ana country clubs for the state tourney Monday, amassed a total of 650 strokes, 41 strokes behind the California leader, San Mateo College.

All three Metropolitan teams represented in state competition finished in the first ten of 20 colleges participating at the tourney. Bakersfield held down fifth place with 633 strokes, Santa Monica placed eighth with 643 and El Camino garnered the ninth slot.

The Warrior score cards were far below those anticipated by coach Al Greenleaf. Scoring for El Camino were Rick Hull, 80-74-154; Jack Hollis, 76-83-159; Mike Stern, 81-81-162 and Garth Reynolds, 90-85-175.

Back of San Mateo College in first was College of Sequoias, 616; Stockton College, 617; Santa Ana, 630; Bakersfield, 633; Orange Coast, 636; Santa Barbara, 641; Santa Monica and the Warriors.

The state tourney closed out a golf season for El Camino that saw 23 season matches with 14 Metro encounters. The team flashed with a 6 and 3 in practice and 11 and 3 for the Metropolitan duels.

Greenleaf's squad won the last five matches of the sea-

son in the heat of pressure pressed on it by Santa Monica and Bakersfield. Most of the year the divit-diggers greatly overwhelmed opponents by beating such teams as East Los Angeles, 52-2; Los Angeles City College, 52-2; Harbor, twice, 52-3; and Los Angeles Valley, 49-5.

Rick Hull, first man for El Camino averaged a 75 for the entire season. Larry Martz placed second this year with a 77 average round for the 23 games played.

"What our team lacked this year was general team consistency, Coach Greenleaf stated. In about every match one or two players would be down and the other four shooting well. Very rarely could we get all six men hitting on the same day. That's what happened at the state tourney; they all fell badly."

Three squeaker losses of the season, all in top division clubs, lost the Metro title for the men of the greens. They lost twice to Santa Monica, 22 to 32 and 26 to 28. The other loss was to Bakersfield, 14 to 40.

"We've got fine promises for next season, Greenleaf beamed. Hull might be back and Hollis, Stern, John Kelley and Steve Crowell might again be swinging the clubs. Nick Erbin may also join our ranks."

Greenleaf's club-swingers finished the year with the best win, loss and standing record of all El Camino teams this year. The squad was one-half game from first place.



SAFETY FEATURES to check in buying a fiber glass boat include hull thickness, type and extent of hull stiffening, transom construction, flotation, fasteners. A measure of the amount and type of stiffeners to look for is provided by this 13-ft. fiber glass boat. It achieves bottom stiffness with an alumi-

num keelson flanked by aluminum bilge keelsons, and transverse fiber glass ribs molded in at 4-inch intervals. Its sides are stiffened by a polyester mortar at the top edge, which is fastened to an outside aluminum and vinyl edging. A cross-piece and the foredeck give rigidity to the bow.




