OUTDOORS WITH MEL

Yes you must have a fishing license when fishing in salt water except from a municipal pier. It cost \$3 and you must buy additional stamps for bass and trout in fresh water. You can buy a 3 day license for salt water and the cost is \$1. You may not take over the legal limit even if you didn't catch your limit the last time you went fishing. Some of the limits are as follows. Baracuda—Limit 10 but not more than 2 fish less than 28 inches in length. Salt Water Bass—This includes Kelp, Spotted, and Sand. Ten limit all over 12 inches. Halibut—Limit 2 any size. Yellowtail—Limit 10 but only 5 allowed under 28 inches.

Here are some of the fresh water laws most abused. Chumming is prohibited and it is illegal to use the meat or flesh of any bird or mammal for bait. In most waters it is unlawful to use any fish either dead or alive or any part of a fish (except salmon eggs or trout roe) for bait.

It is unlawful to bring ashore any fish on which the total size or weight cannot be determined. The limit on trout now is 10 trout but not more than 10 pounds and one trout. Possession means on your person, in your car, cabin, etc. These rules are found in a handy little book called 1960 Sport Fishing Regulations which are available at all sporting goods stores and are free. Ignorance of the laws is no excuse.

Lots of fishing activity at the breakwater these days as more and more fishermen are learning that perch and bass can be caught on some artificials and are really scrappy on light gear. Many people are making their own lead head jigs for Calico bass and are taking the high cost out of rock fishing at night. Its simple and if you'll stop in at Sportsville U.S.A. I will be glad to show you how. These jigs also are great in fresh water and I think there is no more fun than catching fish on lures that have been handmade.

A new federal law is being introduced which will allow fishermen to buy a license to fish in many states. The angler would purchase a license in his home state and then would send an application thru the Post Office for a federal license. This would eliminate the high cost of a out of state license in each state fished. The states would all benefit from the fees collected and would probably get more return than they now get from non resident license sales. Sounds good.


