Flying Farmers to Stop Here on State Tour

The Flying Farmers State-wide Tour of Mayors will honor Torrance by holding a luncheon at the Jump 'N Jack Restaurant Thursday.

The Flying Farmers, an influential group of the state's leading agricultural experts, are hosting 40 mayors from California county-seat cities to a three-day tour of the state.

Overnight stops are scheduled for Palm Springs, Sacramento, and Lake Tahoe. Stops for meals will be at Torrance, San Diego, Bakersfield, San Simeon, San Francisco, Santa Rosa, Redding, Willows, and Fresno.

Mayor Isen of Torrance will make the trip.

The trip is co-sponsored by the League of California Cities to acquaint the mayors with the importance of agriculture to the entire economy of the state, to give the Mayors an opportunity to talk to the farmers about the problems of cities and to enable civic leaders, as well as Mayors and farmers, to discuss mutual problems which include private flying, airports, water, etc.

Attending a no-host luncheon will be the Torrance City Council, Airport Commission, Chamber of Commerce officers, city administrative officials, and aviation executives.

The committee expects at least 150 persons at the luncheon.



Applications for Teacher Interns Being Accepted for City's Schools

Applications for teacher interns in Torrance schools next fall still are being accepted. Personnel Director Robert Morton has announced.

The district will try a pilot program next year in which college liberal arts graduates without formal education training can get a chance to work as teacher assistants.

At the same time, they can take education courses at USC toward a teaching credential.

After a year of helping in the classrooms, attending school part-time during the year and full-time in the summer, a credential may be awarded.

The students would be paid for serving as teacher assistants, but not for student teaching.

Similar programs have been carried on in various other parts of the country. The Ford Foundation did some research into this problem.
