Water Resources Questions Firms About Production

How much water is used to make fire extinguishers in California? How much will be used 10 years from now? How much water is used by all of the state's manufacturing firms today, and how much 10 or 20 years from now?

The answers to these and other questions are being sought by the Department of Water Resources through questionnaires being mailed to manufacturers throughout

the state, according to Harvey O. Banks, department director.

"Up to now," Banks said, "we have largely had to estimate the amounts of water used industrially. In the future, on the basis of replies to these questionnaires, we hope to have much more accurate information to aid us in our planning."

Approximately 27,000 manufacturers will be quizzed on the department's first full coverage of the state's industrial water needs. The investigation is part of an urban water use program authorized by the 1959 legislature.

Banks said the department expects to repeat the questionnaire survey at five-year intervals to reflect changes in industrial processes and water demands. "We hope to be able to estimate trends in industrial needs more accurately so that we may stage water development projects in order of greatest need," Banks said. "The increasing industrialization of the state makes this survey imperative."

Among the questions being asked industries are source of water currently used, method of disposal of discharged water, type of water treatment used, and the quantity of water used related to the quantity of the product manufactured.

Highway Patrol Warns Motorists With Trailers

Warnings to boat owners who tow their boats over public roads have been given recently by Captain E. L. Greer, commander of the Highway Patrol's Compton area. He cautioned the drivers to be sure they have the proper turn signals and other safety requirements on their cars and trailers.

"California law requires trailers carrying loads that extend 24 inches or more to the left of the center of the steering wheel to be equipped with either signal lamps or an approved mechanical signal device," he said.

"Other equipment required on trailers includes one red tail lamp, a license plate lamp, one red reflector and a stop lamp. Two tail lamps and two stop lamps are required on trailers originally registered after Jan. 1, 1958. In addition, the towing vehicle must be equipped with a mirror reflecting a view of the highway 200 feet to the rear."
