

Entrants Gather for Puff Derby

Sixty-eight California women pilots will vie with 99 from 23 other states in the 14th annual A11-Woman Transcontinental Air Race, affectionately dubbed "Powder Puff Derby" by newsmen. The race will start at the Torrance Municipal Airport at 9 a.m. July 9 and end at Wilmington, Delaware on July 13.

Arizona and Michigan with 13 and 12 entrants are runner-ups for the state with the most pilots participating, followed by Illinois, nine; Missouri, Texas and Indiana, eight. Other states represented are Washington, six; New York, five; Idaho, Tennessee, Ohio and Pennsylvania, four; New Jersey, Iowa, Kansas and South Carolina, 3; New Mexico, Colorado, Wisconsin, Nevada, and Alabama, two. Alaska and Washington D.C. both have one representative.

The start is sponsored by the City of Torrance, The Torrance Chamber of Commerce and Ninety-Nines, Inc.


