
Smuggled 'Volga' Highlights Show at Car Dealers

The only Russian-made "Volga" automobile in the United States will aid the Jewish War Veterans in their campaign to raise funds for the support of their program of service to veterans, families of veterans and to the Community.

Smuggled out of the Soviet by Los Angeles businessman and philanthropist, Stanley Slotkin, the "Volga" will be displayed by the Jewish War Veterans, South Bay Post No. 777 from Friday, July 15th to Sunday, July 17th at Newcastle Sports Car Center, Ltd., 505 Pacific Coast Highway, Hermosa Beach, according to Irwin J. Kaplan, Commander of Post No. 777.

"Mr. Slotkin has sponsored many philanthropic projects in recent years. He feels it is quite appropriate that the 'Volga,' supposedly a symbol of achievement of Russian industry, is used to support the program of a democratic organization such as the Jewish War Veterans," pointed out Commander Kaplan.

Protesting actions of the Torrance School Board, A. Richard Kendall, president of Torrance School Employees, Local 1101, union, mentioned that the organization is seeking fringe benefits for the employees.

Benefits sought are a night shift pay differential, a ten cent per hour hike for night workers; overtime pay; call-in pay, whereas an employee would be compensated if called in on emergency; and an all-over raise of \$25 per month.

Kendall mentioned that the board has been putting-off the pleas of the school employees for the fringe benefits because of a lack of funds. However, at the same time, it is able to find the money to hire "high class" employees.
