Big-time automobile racing in the form of the popular CRA Indianapolis-type big cars returns to Ascot Stadium, Saturday night with a full nine event racing program topped by a 30 lap feature over the speedy half-mile clay oval.

Heading the entire list will be Danny Jones, Long Beach, at the wheel of the potent Cotten Chemical Special from Elroy, Arizona. Jones wheeled this machine into the winners circle three times already this year, and will be looking for win number four Saturday evening.

He has just returned from the Pikes Peak, Colorado championship race where he was one of the big money winners.

His top competition will come from three other top pilots, Rosie Rousel, Long Beach; Bob Mathouser, Omaha, Nebraska; and Jack Brunner, Gardena. Rousel has won one main event this year at Ascot driving his Wayne-Chevrolet Special. Mathouser won recently at another track driving his Offenhauser; and Brunner has been running up front in the last four races when

mechanical trouble has put his Corvette engine car out of action.


