She will also be chairman of the hostess committee for the convention. At the opening business session Monday, Mrs. DeJaifre will give the welcoming address to all pilots and co-pilots attending the convention.

Thursday, the California pilots will meet with pilots from Canada and Louisiana for breakfast. Mrs. DeJaifre will extend a welcome to those in attendance.

Gay Nineties costumes will be worn by California pilots at the opening reception Sunday. These outfits are symbolic of San Francisco during that era.

Dr. Lynne C. Monroe, professor of the University of California's department of industrial arts, will be the keynote speaker for the convention. He will speak on "Silken Purses from Sow's Ears." Dr. Monroe is active in a variety of fields in addition to education—particularly Kiwanis International.

A special safety program will be presented also in an attempt to focus attention on pilot's interest in safety.

Boys and girls 10 to 17 years of age are attending the four and a-half-hour classes taught by top-flight instructors at each of the host playgrounds, according to Ralph Borrelli, supervisor of special events in the department.


