

Torrance Scouts Trek to Colorado Jamboree

Boy Scouts and Explorers from Torrance will be among a group of 600 young men from the Los Angeles Area Council to attend the fifth National Boy Scout Jamboree July 22 to 28, in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Camping at the 2000 acre Reverse J Diamond Ranch, site of the immense gathering, will be 56,000 Scouts, Explorers, and their leaders from every state in America, as well as many from 38 foreign lands.

Not only will they partake in the various activities planned for them at the session, but the Scouts will be celebrating their Golden Anniversary.

"For God and Country" is the theme of the Jamboree; its principal purpose is to bring boys and leaders a clearer comprehension of the ideals of Scouting.

"While in attendance each boy will come to realize the full scope of this Jamboree with its own fire departments, bus line, post office, bank, hospitals, barbershops, first aid stations, supermarket trading posts, telephone exchange, amphitheater, broadcasting studios, commissary service, and places for religious worship," a spokesman for the Scouts said.

The Doug Jones Memorial Race which was originally scheduled for June 11, and postponed because of the Catalina Channel Race, has been reset for July 9 and 10 at Salton Sea Beach, between Desert Shores and Salton City.
