

Trips to Space Offered by Park

Hundreds of Southlanders and tourists are viewing Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, and Jupiter during simulated journeys into outer-space at Griffith Park Observatory's planetarium theater, where "A Trip to Mars" is offered daily. It was reported by the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Department.

ence H. Clemmshaw said that a novel feature of the show is a view of Mars' two tiny moons, Phobos and Deimos, as they would be seen from the surface of the distant sphere. He pointed out that the satellites are only 10 miles in diameter and appear as bright stars to the space travelers.

The climax of the current "spectacular" is a simulated landing on Mars, according to Dr. Clemmshaw, who said that the landing is made realistic by paintings of Mars' surface—created by world-famous artist Chesley Bonestell—which are reproduced on the planetarium theater's 75-foot domed ceiling through the use of special projectors.

Museum Exhibits Expensive Egg

A \$25,000 "giant egg" which graphically portrays the miracle of birth is the newest permanent exhibit at the California Museum of Science and Industry in Exposition Park.

The exhibit, a gift of the Union Pacific Railroad, is a nine-foot high, 1800-pound structure built in the shape of an egg. Inside it contains a hatcher-brooder capable of hatching 150 chicks a day.

Through glass panels in the sides of the exhibit, Museum visitors may view the chicks emerge from their shells.
