Electric lights come in handy while Rainey prepares dinner over his butane stove. During cool weather, an additional butane breaks the chill. A built-in ice box keeps

foods fresh.
When Rainey's family accompanies him on outings, a two-way telephone circuit is kept busy between the driver in the cab and the passengers in the camper, which sleeps five adults comfortably.
Additional batteries furnish the power needed to operate the various electronic devices.
Rainey has been an instructor at Harbor since the college opened in 1949. He and his family reside in San Pedro.

Robert H. Whitstock, field representative of The Seeing Eye, Inc., will address the staff of the Braille Institute Aug. 8, on the selection, use and training of guide dogs for blind people, it was announced today.
The meeting will be held in the Atkinson Auditorium lounge, 751 N. Vermont Ave. at 2 p.m.
Whitstock, blind since the age of seven, uses his guide dog, Gem, in traveling over 40,000 miles annually, while serving as liaison between his organization and various state and private groups interested in rehabilitating blind people.
A graduate of Harvard Law School, Whitstock is a Phi Beta Kappa and a member of the New York Bar Association. Before joining the guide dog organization in 1957 as administrative assistant, he served as a history instructor at the New York Institute for the Education of the Blind.
