

Church Leaders Visit Mormon Congregation

Elder Marion D. Hanks, a member of the First Council of Seventy, and Elder LeRoy A. Wirthlin, a member of the General Church Welfare Committee of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints from Salt Lake City, will be the feature speakers Saturday and Sunday, Aug. 27 and 28, during a quarterly conference of the Church's Redondo Stake.

Sunday's general sessions, to which the public is invited, will be held at 9:30 a.m. and 2 p.m., at 2000 W. 175th St., Torrance.

Elder Hanks is a nationally-known youth leader and a member of President Eisenhower's Youth Fitness Committee. He holds a degree in law although he devoted himself to teaching religion before his high church appointment in 1953.

Elder Wirthlin is a director of the Church Welfare Plan. Saturday evening meetings will be for lay church leaders, devoted to the church's local and world-wide mission-

ary program and the church welfare plan.

The church maintains an extensive educational system and has erected 12 sacred temples in North America, Europe and Oceania, and operates farms, canneries and warehouses to care for the welfare of its members.

Since the translation of the Book of Mormon and restoration of the Church more than 130 years ago, membership has grown throughout the world to include thousands of flourishing congregations. An extensive building program is working continually on at least 600 churches to provide for its expanding wards and branches.

Throughout the world, the Church has more than 6,000 missionaries, mostly young men and women, serving from two to three years at their own expense.

Church Features T. Texas Tyler

T. Texas Tyler, known as "The Man With a Million Friends," one of the foremost country and western artists for many years, will be featured at a service in the Harbor City Foursquare Church, Aug. 26th, at 7:30 p.m. according to the Rev. Marion Plies.

This will mark one of the first appearances in this area by T. Texas Tyler, a man who, until recently, spent his time touring throughout the United States and Canada headlining "Grand Ole Opry" shows, appearing with his large bands in ballrooms, clubs, and on TV and other forms of entertainment.

Tyler will tell his story of how he decided to quit this life to become a preacher of the Gospel. He will be playing his guitar and singing many Gospel songs. He was converted in the early part

of 1958 and has since devoted his full time to Gospel work.

Tyler was catapulted to nationwide fame in 1948 with his smash hit, "Deck of Cards," which he wrote. Some of his other record hits were: "Remember Me," "Bumming Around," "Courtin' in the Rain," and many others.

Tyler has the distinction of being one of the very few country and western artists to ever appear in concert at New York's famed Carnegie Hall. He had been under contract to Columbia Studios in Hollywood in the making of Western movies.

In his amazing story to be told in his appearance here Tyler will tell why after 28 years in show business, he gave up all the entertainment world had to offer to utilize all his talents exclusively in Gospel work.
