Local Instructor Explains Child's Behavior Motives

By John de la Haye Perhaps the most frequently asked question of the child psychologist is "How can I get my child to eat?" or more

generally, "How can I get him to mind me?" Today there is a simple answer to these questions, according to George Watt, instructor of child psychology at El Camino College.

Previously, psychologists have hedged their way around a direct answer because the problem has been seen as one too complicated to merit a simple explanation. The problem is still complicated but we are beginning to see a simple answer. That is, if we can bring ourselves to perceive from the child's viewpoint.

A child refuses to eat or creates a problem at bed time simply because he perceives eating and going to bed in such a way that this kind of response to him is a very natural one, Watt explained. If he perceives dinner time as a time to fight with Mamma, then he will fight with Mamma. It is just that simple. So if we wish to change his response, we simply bring about a change in his

perceptions. But now the question arises, "How did he come to see dinner time as an experience of fighting with Mamma?" The answer to this, too, is quite simple. Mamma fights with him, and so he comes to perceive dinner time exactly as it is, a time for fighting.

If, later on, he comes to see policemen as someone to outwit, and his perceptions of other people is one of taking what he can get from them, then he has everything to gain and not much to lose by taking hubcaps and later automobiles.

Although we have given some simple answers, we still have one step further to go for a full explanation of the original question.

We will approach this by pursuing the broader question, "How can I get my child to mind me?" The answer to this, again, seems about as simple and very much the same. Generally speaking, how

well your child minds you depends quite specifically on how he feels about you.

essentially against him, then he will tend to be against you and consequently will not mind you voluntarily. Any of us can validate this in our own experiences.
