School Board Breaks Ground for New Victor Tract School

Groundbreaking ceremonies were held this week for the first of four Torrance elementary schools, slated to serve large new residential subdivisions in the city, for approximately 1800 new homes.

Cost of the new school, Victor, Hickory, and two schools to serve the Walteria Lake area, will cost more than \$2 1/4 million and will add some \$100,000 a year to the district's payroll as the result of the added children.

Work on Victor Elementary School, Spencer and Kieley Corp., with School Board President, William Boswell, Superintendent J. H. Hull, and 10 prospective students at the school, Tammy Brink and Jeff Linsky, taking part in groundbreaking ceremonies.

Victor School will serve the Victor Tract area, where 750 new homes have been scheduled for construction.

Work will start soon on Hickory Avenue School, 230 and Hickory Ave., which will serve a new tract with some 338 homes.

Plans for a 736-home tract in the Walteria Lake area have prompted the district to start plans to obtain a site at 227th and Ladeene and to study possible sites in that general area for an elementary school.

"When I settled down later, I looked him up. I thought maybe I could pay him, but he wouldn't let me do anything. In talking with him, I learned he was a fireman from the Torrance Fire Department.

"I sincerely feel that due to his alertness and fast action, my daughter's life was saved. We certainly will be eternally grateful to him."
