### Armco Steel Corp. Offers Four-Year Scholarship Here

A four-year scholarship, valued at \$650 a year, will again be awarded to some high school senior in the Torrance-Los Nietos area, Armco Steel Corporation, officials announced today.

The scholarship here is one of 21 offered by Armco in the communities where it has plants. It was established last year, following the merger of the National Supply Company with Armco. The Fluid Packed Pump Company, Los Nietos, is a division of National Supply.

Otto C. Ledford, son of Col. and Mrs. Otto C. Ledford, 5210 Calle de Arbole, Torrance, was the winner of the 1960 scholarship.

Competition for the 1961 scholarship is open to seniors in public, private, or parochial high schools in Torrance or Whittier Union High School District who plan to major in engineering, chemistry, or physics. It is not limited to sons and daughters of National Supply or Fluid Packed Pump Company employees.

Aptitude tests will be given in the high schools Oct. 18 and 22.
