Interviewed by the Torrance Press, Bill Boswell, president of the Torrance School Board declared "the wishes of the people have been clearly indicated by the vote. It is gratifying to see the number of people who turned out to vote, indicating their interest in the school system."

"The board will have to determine what action must be taken, because of this loss of income. It appears we will have to return and ask for another override election, but this one will have to have a time limit," he declared.

Dr. J. H. Hull, school superintendent, stated "The board will examine two programs, one, an austerity program, and another, if we are able to obtain an override with a time limit at an early date."

"It is essential to have more funds, if we are going to maintain the present educational program. Regardless of the results, we appreciate the effort of all those who worked for the override, and respect the wishes of those who turned it down."

"We will return again, with a few decision for the voters to make," Hull declared.

Thanking all the people who worked for "this cause," Bert Lynn, city planning commissioner and key spokesman in the drive for a "no" vote, announced "we would gladly endorse a 5 year tax override, following a policy statement from our school board stating that the present 75 cent override will be reduced or eliminated when the need is over."

"It behooves our school administration to tighten up its belt, and clean house. This is no longer a bottomless pit, or an open checkbook for the school board," Lynn declared.


