Vocal Auditions for Messiah' Set at Camino Oct. 18

Auditions for soloists to be selected when students participate in forthcoming performances of Handel's oratorio, "The Messiah," will be conducted at El Camino College at 11 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. Oct. 18.

The classic work will be presented at the 8 p.m. performances on Dec. 4 and 11. R. Neil Hill, choral director, announced. The try-outs for prospective soloists will be held in Music 9.

"Persons desiring to audition should be accomplished in their vocal technique," Hill specified, adding that enrolled students will receive first consideration for solo parts. "Community talent will be insufficiently matured for the demanding arias," Hill declared.

Solo parts are for soprano, alto, tenor and bass voices. Hill announced that persons interested in the auditions should appear at one of the designated times with a n aria from "The Messiah."

"The Messiah" performances will constitute a part of the annual Christmas Festival of Arts, sponsored by the college, uniting dramatic, musical and artistic expressions for the Christmas season.

El Camino to Show Free Atoms in Action Exhibit

"Atoms in Action," one of the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission's newest traveling exhibits, will be shown at El Camino College Oct. 25 through Oct. 31.

The free exhibit, open to the public, is sponsored by the Division of Physical Science, El Camino College, and will be shown at the Physical Science Building from 9 a.m. until 9 p.m.

"Atoms in Action" consists of colorful panels and models designed to provide explanation of the many peaceful uses of atomic energy in a graphic, easy-to-understand manner.

One panel describes the principal components of the atom—the building blocks of the universe. Another explains how useful energy is obtained by atomic fission—the splitting of atoms of heavy elements such as uranium and plutonium. Other panels demonstrate how radioactive materials are used in agriculture, medicine, and industry.

Visitors will also see a "free island" exhibit: an animated model of an atomic power plant; an illuminated explanation of the fusion process, where power is produced by uniting atoms of light elements at extremely high temperatures and pressures; and a three-foot model of the N. S. Savannah—the nation's first nuclear-propelled merchant ship.

The Lark's refinements and improvements are evident not only in actual use of the car, says Rule, but in the longer life of important components, adding to comfort and safety, and greater ease in servicing.

With its all-new 112-horsepower overhead valve power plant, the Lark Six has special features to match its more powerful engine.

A new automatic transmission and a new converter incorporate such features as a one-way clutch to provide for smoother shifting characteristics. The clutch has been increased from 8 to 9-1/8 inches. New linkless sway bars are standard equipment.

Munchin' Good Cookies Are Delightful Snacks

All ages love cookies. They are good to munch on when doing home work; listening to records; or watching a thriller on television.

Here are two favorites:

Old-Fashioned Sugar Cookies

1/2 cup (1 stick) margarine or butter
3/4 cup sugar
1 egg
1/2 tsp. vanilla
1/2 tsp. grated lemon rind
1/2 tsp. baking powder
1/4 tsp. salt
2 cups sifted flour
2 tbsps milk

Thoroughly cream margarine or butter and sugar. Add egg and beat well. Add vanilla and grated lemon rind. Sift remaining dry ingredients together and add alternately with milk; mix thoroughly. Roll one-eighth inch thick on lightly floured surface. Cut with floured cookie cutter, sprinkle with sugar. Bake in moderately hot oven (375 degrees) 10 to 12 minutes. (If desired, refrigerate dough before using).

Jam-Filled Cookies

3 1/2 cups sifted cake flour
2 tps. baking powder
1/2 tsp. salt
1/2 cup shortening
1 cup sugar
2 eggs, well beaten
2 tbsps. cream
1 tsp. vanilla
Confectioners' sugar
Raspberry jam and pineapple jam

Mix and sift flour, baking powder and salt. Set aside. Cream shortening and sugar together; beat until light. Add eggs, cream and vanilla; beat well. Stir in dry ingredients until blended. Shape into ball and wrap in waxed paper. Chill three hours. Sprinkle pastry board with confectioners' sugar.

Divide dough in halves and roll out each half about one-eighth inch thick. Cut one half with doughnut cutter and cut second half with plain round cutter of same diameter. Place all rounds on cookies sheets and bake in moderate oven, 375 degrees, about eight minutes or until lightly browned. Remove cookies from sheet and cool on rack. Spread plain rounds with jam and top with doughnut shaped rounds. Makes about two dozen.
