

Tasty Pie Dessert Pumpkin Chiffon

Russet leaves, red apples, colorful football banners, and orange pumpkins! These mean autumn is here—autumn with its brisk mornings and cool evenings and in between its round of vigorous activity for all, at home, at school, at work, inside and out.

For mothers autumn means the need for preparing hearty meals, hearty from soup through dessert. Tops among the desserts suitable for autumn dinners is that symbol of autumn, pumpkin pie itself.

Pumpkin pie with its spicy, rich, smooth, honey-sweetened filling placed in a graham cracker crust and further

enhanced with a topping of whipped cream sweetened with honey is at once a food and a treat for every member at the family table.

Honey will make it a real treat for all by imparting honey flavor and aroma to the dessert; honey will also add nourishment vitamins and minerals to make the filling even more substantial. Here is a tested recipe to try.

Honey Pumpkin Chiffon Pie

Graham Cracker Crust:
20 graham crackers
(1-2/3 cups)
1/4 cup sifted confectioner's sugar

1/4 cup soft butter
Crush the graham crackers very fine. Blend in the sugar and soft butter. Press the mixture into a heat-resistant deep 10-inch pie dish. Bake at 375 degrees F. 10 minutes.

Filling:
1 tablespoon plain gelatin
1/4 cup cold water
3 eggs
3/4 cup honey
2 cups cooked pumpkin
1/2 cup whole milk
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon ginger
1/4 teaspoon cloves
3 tablespoons sugar
1/2 pt. whipping cream
Soak gelatin in cold water 5 minutes. Beat egg yolks and combine with honey, pump-

kin, milk, salt and spices. Cook in top of double boiler until thick, stirring constantly. Remove from fire, add softened gelatin and stir until dissolved. Beat egg whites until frothy. Add sugar gradually and continue beating until they stand in peaks. Fold the egg whites into pumpkin mixture. Turn into graham crust and chill for several hours. Top with whipped cream.
