### Explorers, Scouts Tour Naval Ship

Navy repair ship, USS Hector was host to Boy Scout Troop 315 and Explorer Post 315X recently.

Torrance Moose Lodge 785 is the sponsor for both groups. Arrangements for the trip aboard the ship were made by committeemen, Dan Reyes and Herb Shattuck.

Highlights of the trip was the Scouts reading Morse code light signals from an admiral aboard an aircraft carrier. The message was "Boy Scouts of America Forever."

A morning snack of milk, coffee and doughnuts was served after leaving the harbor area.

Off Catalina Island, the Hector staged a man-overboard drill with a helicopter aiding in the rescue.

A buffet lunch was served to the men and boys at noon. Captain R. Ack and his entire ship's company were host to 22 Scouts and 7 adults from Troop 315; and to 14 Explorers and 3 adults from Post 315X.

After the Hector dropped anchor, the group came ashore in motor launches.

### Fire in Pits Weekends Only

The fire pit area at Isadore B. Dockweiler Beach State Park, Playa del Rey, will be closed evenings Monday through Thursday, it was reported yesterday by the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Department.

Friday, Saturday, and Sunday-evening operation of the popular fire pit area will continue through November 13, according to Chief Beach Life-guard Myron Cox, who said that the pits will close at 5 p.m. from Nov. 13 until next Spring.

### PERSIMMON

As a small tree, the Persimmon is really hard to beat in Southern California. Its moderate growth to some 25 feet is not enough to overpower even a small garden, and its form is as graceful as any garden tree you could name. In fall, while the luscious fruit is turning a brilliant orange, the leaves take on lighter shades of autumn which few other specimens do in our mild climate. As to care, the Persimmon can do with very little or none at all.

### For Adventure Eating-'Bobotee'

Do you like to try new things? Do 'foreign' foods seem like food adventuring to you?

Here is new delight to try from South Africa. It has the delightful name "Bobotee."

### "BOBOTE"

1/2 cup onion, chopped  
2 tablespoons butter or oil  
1 slice of white bread  
1 cup milk  
2 eggs, beaten  
1 pound ground beef  
1/2 teaspoons to 1 table-spoon curry powder  
Juice of 1 lemon  
12 almonds, chopped  
8 dried apricots, soaked and chopped  
3/4 cup chutney  
Salt and pepper to taste  
Saute onion in butter or oil until golden brown.  
Soak bread in milk, remove and squeeze dry. Add beaten eggs to milk.

Mix the beef with bread, onion, curry powder, lemon juice, almonds, apricots, chutney, salt and pepper.

Add half egg mixture and blend well. Place in a greased shallow baking dish or 6 individual casseroles. Allow center slightly to allow for rising.

Bake in moderate oven (350) deg. for 20 minutes. Remove and pour rest of egg mixture on top.

Return to oven and continue baking until custard sets, about 25 minutes. Serve with yellow rice. Serves 6.

If your hat should get wet from rain, turn the brim up before putting it away and allow it to dry at room temperature. Felt hats will retain their shape and beauty much longer if you brush them with a soft, urethane foam lint brush before each wearing.
