


Windbreak Fence With Planter Top

Would you like to have a tall fence that doesn't look like a tall fence?

To insure the yard's privacy or to block prevailing winds, fences 6 or 8 feet high are often necessary. But even with such height, that fence can be graceful. Here's how.

Build a planter about 2 feet high along the fence line and top it with a seat of Douglas fir 2x3s, laid on edge and spaced very slightly apart to make an interesting pattern. The seat should be cantilevered several inches out from the planter's edge.

Then fill the planter with greenery, some of which should be vines trained to climb the fence. Used as a

backdrop for the shrubbery and with its height broken by the strong horizontal line of the garden seat, the tall fence will become an object of beauty in the yard.

CHECK FILE

Be sure — to check your tag file for "bleach" directions. Many wash-and-wear finishes are chemically affected by chlorine bleaches.

Some fabrics turn yellow. Others fall into holes. That's why so many tags warn "Don't Bleach."

When a tag says "chlorine resistant" you can know the fabric maker has prepared for this hazard, and eliminated the danger.


