Henry Mancini Set For Stereo Concert

Seven of the nation's top jazz musicians have been signed by Henry Mancini for his stereo concert appearance on Saturday night, December 3, at the Santa Monica Civic Auditorium. Each artist, a virtuoso instrumentalist in his own right, will play ensemble with the Mancini recording orchestra and also will be heard in solo during the evening's presentation. The seven include Pete Condon, trumpet; Dick Nash, trombone; Jack Sperling, drums; Rolly Bundock, bass; Larry Bunker, vibes; Ronnie Lang, sax; and Harry Klee, flute.

Over \$30,000 worth of sound equipment is being set up in the auditorium, by the James B. Lansing Sound Co. The performance will be similar to a typical stereo recording session such as Mancini does each week for one of the Peter Gunn TV series. **HONOR QUEEN WORSHIPS**
