# Reed Hadley in KTTV Spy Drama Tuesday

One of the most accomplished dramatic actors in the American theater Reed Hadley, stars in the Shulton Holiday Playhouse presentation of "Underwater Agent," to be seen Tuesday, Dec. 6, 8 p.m., on KTTV, Channel Eleven.

Hadley, star of television, motion pictures, radio and the legitimate theater, is cast as U.S. intelligence man David Harding in the documented drama.

Headlines were created in newspapers around the world a few years ago by the disappearance of a frogman in the harbor of Portsmouth, England, near the dock of a visiting Russian cruiser.

Now, for the first time on television, "Underwater Agent" reveals the secret of the frogman's disappearance, based on files and records of one of our intelligence agencies.

The ship's captain is alerted to the frogman's presence by means of the vessel's secret underwater TV cameras. A second secret device traps the diver against the hull of the ship.

Hadley, tall Texan who gave up aspirations of an architectural engineering career to become a dramatic actor, has played in dozens of feature films including "Guadalcanal Diary," "A Boy For Adano," and "Leave Her To Heaven," and was acclaimed widely for his narration of "House on 92nd Street," film dealing with Nazi espionage in America. He possesses one of the most authoritative voices in the entertainment world.

## Hirsch Movie on Channel 2 Saturday

"Crazylegs, All-American," based on the colorful football career of Elroy Hirsch, two-time All-American, star end of the Los Angeles Rams and currently General Manager of the club, will have its Los Angeles premiere telecast on "The Early Show," Saturday, Dec. 10, 5:30 to 6:55 p.m., on KNXT, Channel 2.

The Saturday afternoon lineup on this date will give football fans plenty to cheer about. At 12:45 Jim Healy hosts a program of filmed highlights of the great Ram-Green Bay Packer clash at Milwaukee on Oct. 12, 1952. Following "Pro Football Preview," Johnny Lujack covers the outstanding plays of the previous Sunday's Ram-49er tilt on "Pro Football Kickoff." The Green Bay Packer-San Francisco 49er game follows with Bob Fouts calling the action and Gordy Soltau providing the color.

Capping the sports schedule will be the motion picture debut with Elroy Hirsch starring in his life story. The film's greatest value lies in the fact that the thrill-packed football scenes of the different plays are authentic. They were shot by the producers during the actual games in which Hirsch participated.

"Crazylegs, All-American" covers the football great's story from his days as a fleet half-back on the Wasau, Wisconsin High School team, through his University of Wisconsin gridiron feats, to his record-setting career with the professional Rams.

In addition to Hirsch, the cast includes Lloyd Nolan as the high school football coach who guided the aspiring athlete to his success, and Joan Vohs as his sweetheart.
