

### Questionnaire on Pension, Income Due This Month

Veterans and dependents of deceased veterans on the Veterans Administration pension rolls are urged by the VA to complete and return promptly the income questionnaires they will receive in January.

The questionnaire—a tabulating card—along with complete instructions for filling it out, will go to every disabled veteran, widow and orphan receiving pension payments from the VA, and to the parents of deceased veterans who are receiving dependency and indemnity compensation.

**ENCLOSED WITH CHECKS**  
The cards and instructions will be enclosed with pension checks received on or about January 1. The completed cards must be returned on or about January 1. The completed cards must be returned to the VA not later than January 31, or, under law, payments must be discontinued.

Pension is paid to an eligible veteran whose disability is not result of his military service, and to eligible survivors of these veterans.

The income questionnaires are not sent to disabled veterans receiving compensation since compensation payments, based on disabilities due to military service, are not affected by the recipient's income nor net worth.

Here's the VA's advice to those receiving the questionnaires:

1. Fill out the card completely, following the instructions carefully.
2. Do not bend, staple, pin, cut, tear or mutilate the card, as it is machine-processed when returned to the VA.
3. Sign the card. Unsigned cards must be returned for signature.
4. Return the card promptly.

### Warning Issued Against 'Death Trap' Heaters

Lowell Nelson, chief of the Division of Housing, Department of Industrial Relations, this week warned the people of California to be on the lookout for deadly unvented gas heaters installed in trailers.

An unvented, manually operated, liquefied petroleum gas heater has been responsible for one death already this year by carbon monoxide in the State of Maryland. Last year 23 lives were lost in midwestern states due to a similar unvented heater. Maryland officials report that 60 or more of these unsafe units have been sold to our trailer company.

Nelson emphasized that California's rules and regulations covering trailer coaches sold or offered for sale in California require that all heaters, as well as plumbing and electrical equipment and installations, meet rigid standards and tests by an approved testing agency prior to being approved by the division of Housing for installation in trailer coaches.

**STERN WARNING**  
Nelson said that the division is issuing stern warning against bootleg installation of such unapproved heaters in trailers sold in California. Nelson further emphasized that division field personnel are on the alert for any illegal installations and continuous surveillance is being maintained for trailer coaches coming into California from out of state that may be equipped with the heaters.

California is the only state in the country having minimum standards covering plumbing, heating, and electrical equipment and installations specifically for trailer coaches to protect the health and safety of trailer occupants and the public. However, until these 60 death heaters are located and their use discontinued, the lives of 60 or more people are in danger.

The Division of Housing will continue its cooperative program with the State Department of Public Health and with other states to stamp out this death menace.


