A delegation of 16 represented the Torrance YMCA at the 27th annual meeting of the Pacific Southwest Area Council of the YMCA in San Diego this weekend.

Heading the local group were Dr. and Mrs. Rollin R. Smith, Charter Board Member. Twelve young people training for a professional YMCA career also attended from Torrance. They were Carol Stolley, Karen Payne, Pat Conner, and Mrs. Forrest Thomas.

In addition to the business of the council, small group sessions this year provided information and discussion useful in developing a better understanding of YMCA purpose, family program, and capital development, all in new tools of work for the 60's. This meeting commemorates the 100th Anniversary of YMCA service to the men of the Armed Forces. Work with servicemen began during the Civil War, and has continued to the present.

Attending were Stanley Ellis, Paul Slyh, Jr., David Warden, Julius Meier, Marshall Shipley, Neil Christian, Max Backer, and Kenneth Helphand. Joseph Wilcox, executive secretary, and Mrs. Wilcox also attended the meetings.
