Very Californian, too are companion jackets and skirts for swim suits, especially for the bikini crowd.


**IN LOVE WITH SILK**

So for a bright fashion season—"go West, m'lady"—West, of course, to California—for fashion excitement!


**DRESS SHIRTS**


