

Sea Exploration Exhibition at County Museum

"Exploring the Sea: An Introduction to Marine Biology"—an unusual exhibition of photographs—is now on view at the Los Angeles County Museum. It comprises photographic enlargements from the files of Dr. David K. Caldwell, curator of marine zoology, and is the first of several temporary exhibitions to be displayed in the projected new Marine Hall on the second floor.

According to Dr. Caldwell, the exhibition features en-

largements from approximately 100 35-mm Kodachrome slides in his files. On view will be color transparencies, opaque color prints and black and white prints of marine scenes and organisms, and research activities photographed along the coasts of Southern California, Jamaica, Florida, Georgia, Cuba, Mexico, the Bahamas, Texas and North Carolina.

The exhibition has been planned to spotlight two phases of marine biology; Ec-

ology (relationship of organisms to their environment) in the form of examples of various marine habitats; and avenues which marine research can follow (types of exploration, sources of specimens, observations in tanks and in nature, etc.).

Museum visitors will be able to see photographs of such marine subjects of 200-pound sea turtles, sharks, porpoises, abalone, a giant moray eel, and a sailfish, as well as such shore birds as flamingos and Great White Herons. Two of the photographs won first and second prize in a statewide photography exhibition in Kentucky.

The museum is open daily except Mondays from 10 to 5.
