Sears Store, Del Amo Center, Tuesday, April 12 through Saturday, April 15 will be hosted by the South Bay Sandpipers Club. Gamma Psi of Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority will act as relief hostesses when needed. The exhibit, featuring mock-ups and graphic materials specifically built into a thirty-five foot bus, is free to the public. Literature of various types will be available at no charge. The mobile unit represents the combined efforts of local researchers, sociologists and educators to inform residents of Los Angeles County how best to protect themselves against cancer. Exhibits prepared by medical schools show methods by which scientists are attempting to learn more about the nature and causes of cancer. Air pollution and its relation to lung cancer is the subject of a visual presentation prepared by the University of Southern California. UCLA's display shows the manner in

which laboratory mice have been immunized to resist certain types of cancer and the College of Medical Evangelists' entry depicts differences between healthy cells and abnormal cancer cells. **DIFFERENT PHASES** Other exhibits portray different phases of the American Cancer Society's three-fold program, including how it serves cancer patients.
