## Works of Two 20th Century Artists On Exhibit in LA County Museum

The masterworks of one of the most brilliant and most tortured artists of the 20th century—Amedeo Modigliani (1884-1920)—are now on exhibition at the Los Angeles County Museum. The show opened to the public, March 28, following Museum Association reception and preview attended by one of the largest crowds of the season. The most comprehensive showing of the artist ever exhibited in America, it will continue through April 30. It is an admission fee exhibition—50 cents for adults and 25 cents for children. Valued at \$4,000,000, the

exhibition comprises 44 paintings and 40 drawings assembled by the Los Angeles County Museum under the direction of Frederick S. Wight, head of the art galleries at UCLA, from public and private collections in the United States, Canada and England. Many of the works were traded for food and drink during the artist's lifetime. **LIFE AND LEGEND** Legend has made a familiar story of Modigliani's brief and tragic life. Born in Italy in 1884, he went to Paris in 1906 and in the decade beginning in 1909 he produced his superb portraits and

nudes. Overwork and poverty, drink and drugs were wrecking his health and he died in 1920 at the age of 36. A large part of the works displayed were lent by the Southland's leading collectors. Works have also been lent by collectors in Chicago, New York, New Orleans, St. Louis, Washington, D.C., London, Cleveland, Toronto, and by such museums as the Baltimore Museum of Art, Art Institute of Chicago, Detroit Institute of Arts, Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum, New York, Museum of Modern Art, New York, and the Tate Gallery, London.

As an added attraction, art enthusiasts are offered an opportunity to see the West Coast premier engagement of a new French feature film titled "Modigliani of Montparnasse" starring Gerard Philipe and Lili Palmer. It is presented in the Jean Delacour Auditorium Tuesday through Saturday afternoons at 1 p.m. and again at 3 p.m. and on Sundays at 12 noon. Evening showings are scheduled for Tuesdays and Fridays at 8 p.m. Tickets at \$2 are on sale at the box office one half hour before show time. During the Modigliani exhibition the museum will re-
