### John Dulin to Attend NSF Summer Program

John Dulin, chemistry instructor at El Camino College since the opening of the school, will attend Oregon State College this summer following receipt of his fourth appointment to a National Science Foundation sponsored summer program for college teachers of chemistry. Dulin will attend the summer institute at Corvallis, Oregon, from June 26 to August 4. At Oregon State, Dulin will have the opportunity to study the development of instrumental methods in analytical chemistry, recent developments in inorganic chemistry, and recent advances in organic chemistry during the summer program. He will also participate in a seminar designed primarily to discuss the problems associated with teaching chemistry, with particular emphasis on the more recent techniques developed for teaching general chemistry.
